What To Do After a Car Accident

The Denver car accident lawyers at Ramos Law recommend taking the following steps if you have been involved in a car accident in Colorado or Denver:

Check if Anyone is Injured: Assess the situation and determine if anyone has been injured. If there are severe injuries, call 911 immediately. If you can safely do so, assist anyone in need.
Get to Safety: If anyone has significant injuries, avoid moving them until emergency responders arrive. Otherwise, move your vehicle to the side of the road to prevent further accidents.
Call the Police: Colorado law requires you to report accidents involving injuries, fatalities, or property damage over \$1,000. The police will help determine fault and secure the accident scene. Be sure to get the officers' names, badge numbers, and ask how to obtain a copy of the police report.
Collect Evidence at the Scene: Take photos of the vehicles, any injuries, and the surrounding area. Exchange insurance information, gather contact details from witnesses, and document your recollection of the accident. This evidence will help strengthen your legal claim and provide crucial details later.
Get Medical Treatment: Seek medical attention even for minor injuries, as some conditions, like whiplash, may not present symptoms immediately. Proper documentation of injuries is essential for maximizing compensation from insurance, especially for delayed-onset injuries.
Be Cautious with the Insurance Company: While you should notify the at-fault driver's insurance company, be careful about making any statements regarding injuries or liability. Insurers may use this information to downplay or reduce your claim
